## SHCTC Specialty Show Covid-19 Safety Rules

We want to provide you with a fun and memorable show here in Lake Elmo, Minnesota.

To provide everyone involved in the Show with a safe environment and to do everything possible to Stop The Spread, we have established these rules for the entire event and show site.

Please read them carefully and commit to following them. They apply to ALL – NO exceptions. If you cannot or will not follow these rules, do not come. If you feel sick or believe you may have been exposed to COVID-19, do not come.

### Upon arrival

- Please have your proof of entry available.
- Please groom by your vehicle.
- Face masks or shields covering nose and mouth must be worn at all times unless eating or drinking. If you are out of your vehicle, you are wearing a mask.
- Please present your signed Waiver at the Show Secretary's table. Signed Waiver is required to receive your armbands and wristband for presence in building. No signed Waiver, No armbands, No show.
- SHCTC Safety Rules are included in the envelope with your armbands. Please read them and follow them at all times.
- Catalogs may be purchased at Show Secretary's table. \$5 for both days, exact change preferred. There will be no catalogs available at the rings or the Show Secretary's table for public reference.
- Based on weather conditions, entry numbers, and Covid-19 building occupancy limits, the Club may allow limited grooming inside. This will be announced when you arrive.

### General Practices

- This is a **private event** for entered participants only. **NO spectators.**
- **Entry Confirmation form required to enter.**
- *There is no indoor grooming. Please **groom next to your vehicle.***
- No blow dryers allowed on the show grounds.
- Bring what you need to keep your dog comfortable. **Pop-ups will be permitted** and must be removed daily.
- Every person entering the show site will be **required to provide a signed waiver (see page 31/32)**, indicating that they are healthy, acknowledge the risks in participating, and commit to follow the rules and instructions set forth by the Show Committee.
- This is a **low-touch, Show & Go** event. Please depart after you are done showing.
- **Face masks** covering nose and mouth must be worn at all times unless eating or drinking. If you are out of your vehicle, you are wearing a mask.
- Maintain **social distance** of at least 6 feet from people not staying with you.

- Avoid shaking hands, hugging or other physical contact.
- Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
- Please **wash hands frequently**. If unable to wash with soap and water, please use sanitizer. Hand sanitizer will be provided by the club inside.
- **Clean up after your dog.** Multiple disposal buckets are located in all areas of the grounds.

### Rings

- **Maintain social distancing at all times.**
- **No ringside seating!**
- **Limited inside crating** will be available.
- **Masks must be worn** at all times, including when gaiting your dog.
- Please **respect the directions and space** of the judge and steward. If you need something inside the ring, ask.
- **Use the designated in and out gates** to minimize contact with others.

### Show Secretary's Area

- Exhibitors wanting to be helped must **maintain 6 ft. distance from the next patron.**
- **Masks must be worn** at all times.
- **Forms** will be handed out upon request.
- Exhibitors are requested to **bring and use their own pen** to fill out forms.
- There will be **no public catalog available for reference.**

### General Building Rules

- Please be aware that as of the date of publication of this judging program, Minnesota State Covid-19 regulations, based on the capacity of the venue, only allow 73 people to be inside the building at one time. This will be monitored by club members. We have recently seen a loosening of restrictions in our state. If this changes, at a later date, the new guidelines will be posted at the show site.
- Be aware that there will be designated entrances and exits to the building. Please abide by these to minimize close contact with others.

Failure to follow the rules of the SHCTC Specialty Show, including the COVID-19 safety rules, may result in immediate dismissal from the show grounds and a show committee hearing following AKC guidelines.

All dogs and equipment must be removed within one hour after the completion of judging on Sunday.

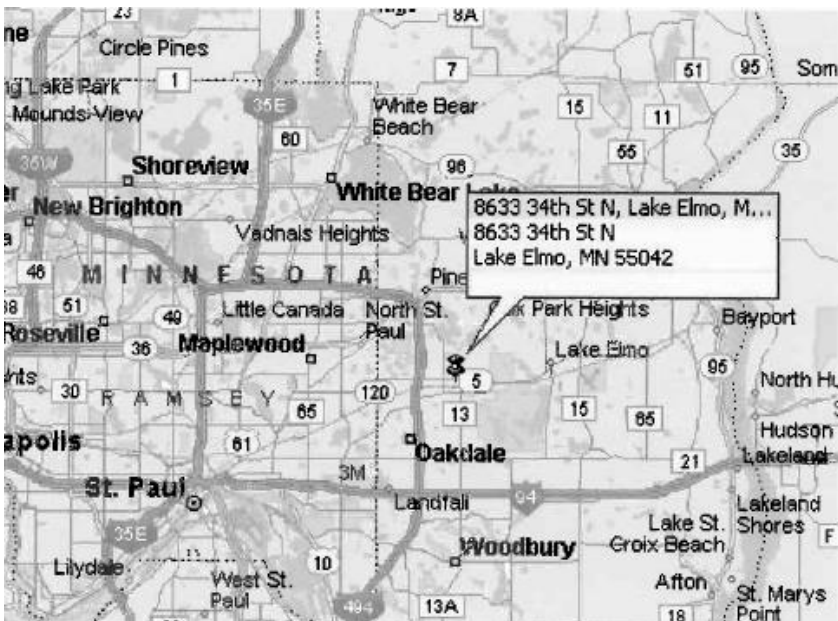
**No chalk or powder inside the building.**

**Directions to the Show Site:**

**From the West/North:** Take I-694 East/South. 2.2 miles past Highway 36, take Highway 14 (Old MN Hwy 5) exit. Go East (left) on Highway 14 for 1.9 miles. Animal Inn is on your right. At the bottom of the driveway, the training center is the building on your left.

**From the East/South:** From I-494/I-694/I-94 intersection in Woodbury/Oakdale, take Highway 694 North for 3.1 miles to Highway 14 (Old MN Hwy 5). Go East (right) on Highway 14 for 1.9 miles. Animal Inn is on your right. At the bottom of the driveway, the training center is the building on your left.
